

GIANT AEROPLANE. FLIGHT OVER THE ATLANTIC.

NEW YORK, Thursday.

The St. John's correspondent of the "New York Times" myst that the Handley-Tage bombing hiphane which is being assembled will be then largest aeroplane to attempt the Transatlantic flight. Fully loaded, the medaine will carry 29,933h. It is equipped with four Rolls-Royce sught-typinder cugines, generating a total of 1500 horse-power. 





Carnations form pleuty of roots and will go a long way in search of food, and this is a habit which should be encouraged, as a plant with a well distributed root system is less likely to damp off than one that has its roots confined under the cover of the grass, as the leaves of carnations are termed. Damping off is the bans of the carnation grower, and is very difficult to fight. Perfect drainage, a light, friable soil, and young, healthy plants are the best means of combating it. The plants should be bia, apart in the beds, and the colours arranged so that when in flower the appearance of the best will be pleasing. When planting make a large hole so that the roots can be well spread cut, and do not plant too deeper in the permanent bed than it was in the nursery. Water only moderately until growth starts, then if the weather fa dry more moisture may be given. Once the plants are growing strongly, more feeding can be given in the way of a mulch of out stable manure and a sprinkling of bone-dust. Lime is very beneficial to carnations, and this should be applied every now and again. Plants can be propagated by cuttings and layers, or raised from seed, and it is advisable to have a number of young plants always ready to put out in case any of the old ones should go off.

Azaless should be given a top-dressting of old cow-manure at this season, so as to get a healthy growth going for the flowering period in the early appring. 


